Markers - (need 2) Markers are small rings that go on your needle between stitches to mark the place. They eliminate the need to count stitches on every row. To use on this pattern; on row one place a marker on the needle right before each P1 stitch. Now on even rows just pass the stitch to the other needle. On odd rows pass the marker to the other needle and make a pearl stitch (P1).

You will need #10 needles, darning needle, scissors and 1 skein of worsted weight yarn. The knitting is done with 2 strands of yarn together. They can be the same or different colors

Markers - (need 2) Markers are small rings that go on your needle between stitches to mark the place. They eliminate the need to count stitches on every row. To use on this pattern; on row one place a marker on the needle right before each P1 stitch. Now on even rows just pass the stitch to the other needle. On odd rows pass the marker to the other needle and make a pearl stitch (P1).
